COLOMBO

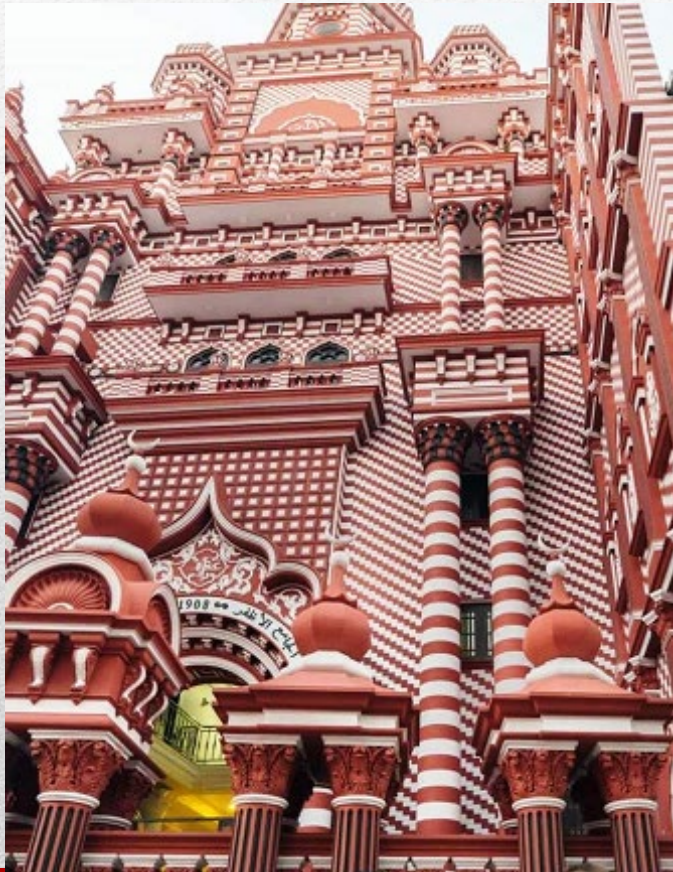
TEMPLE OF SRI KAILAWASANATHAN SWAMI DEVASTHANAM KOVIL [COLOMBO]

Also called Captain's Garden Kovil, this is Colombo's oldest **Hindu Temple**.



Jami-Ul-Alfar Mosque

One of the **oldest mosques** in the city, Jami Ul-Alfar dates back to 1909 and features some gorgeous architecture that draws on lots of different styles.



BEAUTIFUL COLONIAL BUILDINGS IN THE FORT AREA [COLOMBO]

All around downtown Colombo 1, in the Fort Area, there are stunning monumental buildings dating back to the Dutch and British era of Sri Lanka.



Independence Memorial Hall

Built between 1949 and 1953, Independence Memorial Hall was erected to commemorate the country's independence.



Galle Face Green [Colombo]

A beautiful stretch of open space sandwiched between the bustling Galle road and the Indian Ocean.



National Museum of Colombo

Established during 1877, this is the biggest museum in the island nation and is undoubtedly the pride of Sri Lanka.



Colombo Lotus Tower

One of the most unique structures in Colombo, the Lotus Tower is nearly 350 meters tall and towers over Slave Island.



Old Dutch Hospital [Colombo]

Established in the 17th century, the Old Dutch Hospital is one of the oldest and most well-preserved buildings in Colombo. Although the building served many different purposes over the years, it has now been turned into a shopping center.



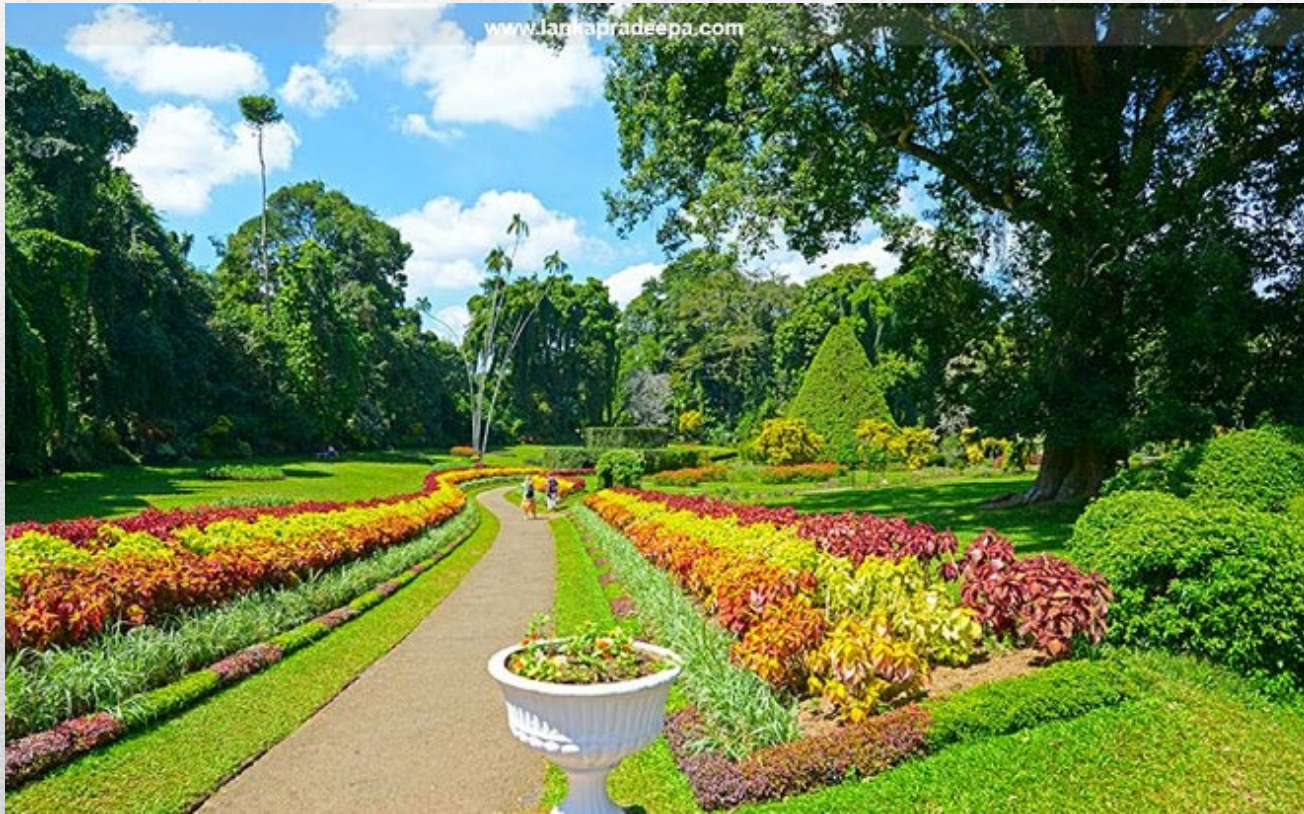
PINNAWALA ELEPHANT ORPHANAGE – Rabukkana KANDY

Royal Botanical Garden –Peradeniya KANDY

Water Falls in Sri Lanka – Bakers Falls

Baker's Falls is a famous waterfall in Sri Lanka. It is located in the Horton Plains National Park.



Sigiriya and Dambulla

Sigiriya, an ancient palace, was once nominated as the 8th wonder of the world.. It is home to an ancient cave Temple also known as the Golden Rock Temple.



Anuradhapura and Polonnaruwa - Sri Lanka's Ancient Capitals

Anuradhapura has been Sri Lanka's capital for about one thousand years, starting from 380 BC, when Buddhism was making its appearance into the country.



Polonnaruwa the city that has been Sri Lanka's second capital for three centuries. Being far less ancient, here the ruins are better preserved.



JAFFNA

Jaffna is one of the most beautiful towns located right on the northern tip of Sri Lanka.
